Final Exam Rules 2017-2018:

- Exams are mandatory in all classes. Students must turn in laptops at their last exam.
- Students in an AP course in which they have taken the corresponding AP exam or facsimile are exempt from the final AP course exam.
- Monday, June 18th and Tuesday, June 19th, students are expected to attend all classes and study halls. Beginning Wednesday, June 20st, students only need to attend school when they have exams.
- On Wednesday, June 20st and Thursday, June 21st, all students on school premises during exam times are required to be in one of three locations: (1) exam room, (2) Commons, or (3) Learning Commons.
- Cell phones and other electronic devices should not be used for any reason during an exam, and must remain turned off.
- No locker or parking lot passes will be issued during exam periods. Only one bathroom pass will be issued at a time, and phones must remain in the exam rooms. Exam areas shall be quiet the entire testing period.
- Students who finish exams early must remain in the exam room until the end of the period.
- Students who fail to take a final exam will automatically fail the course.
- Students must take final exams during the scheduled time unless prior approval has been received from the Principal to take the exam(s) on an alternate date or time.
- Study halls will meet in the regularly scheduled room through Tuesday, June 19th. Beginning Wednesday, June 20th, all teachers who are normally assigned to study halls during periods when exams are scheduled are required to be in the Commons unless assigned to some other duty.
- The last mandatory Region 10 day is Tuesday, June 19th. Transportation will not be provided to and from Region 10 after this date.
- The final day for late buses is Tuesday, June 19th. There will be no bus service for high school students on Friday, June 22nd. Students who have make up exams that day must speak with an assistant principal if there is a need to access district transportation on June 22nd.
- Breakfast and lunch will be served through Thursday, June 21st.
